PHU QUOC – DA NANG – HA NOI (9 days – 8 nights)

Pick up: Phu Quoc (PQC)

See off: Hanoi (HAN)

Day 1: Arrival to Phu Quoc Island – Grand World (L/D)

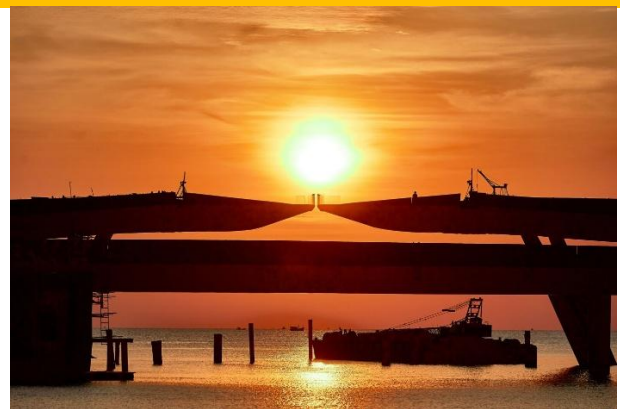


Morning flight to Phu Quoc Island (airfare is not included), check in hotel in Phu Quoc (check in time at 3:00 pm onward). Afterwards, driver will pick you up and go for Grand World. We start with discovering "**The Legend of Bamboo**" artwork: the largest bamboo artwork in Vietnam (32 thousand bamboo trees). This work is a delicate combination of three Vietnamese cultural symbols: lotus, drum and a bamboo. Then, Grand World night market, admire street art shows. And the last stop is "Colors of Venice or Laser Show" show (free): the art show on the water, recreating the love story of the artist and the lady on the romantic Venice river. In the evening, back to hotel and overnight.

Day 2: Tour Islands by Speedboat & Cable Car – Sunset Town & Symphony Show (B/L/D)



After breakfast, transfer to **An Thoi boat station**, get on a speed boat and cruise to 4 islands in Southern of main island. The first place is **Fingernail Island (Mong Tay Island)** is considered as a relaxing heaven with some awesome beaches, a very limpid sea water and smooth waves. **Then, Gam Ghi Island (Dam Ngang)** will let you admire a range number of colorful corals (*your own expense*). Next, **May Rut Trong Island or May Rut Ngoai Island**: It have the longest beach in the islands. On the shore along the beach, there are shady

coconut trees, adding to the pristine beauty of this land. The rows full of coconuts in the middle of the range, not too high, along with the inclined bodies on the beach, are like waving to invite you to pick. Afternoon, go ahead to **Hon Thom island**, enjoy water park, then use cable car to return to main island, this is the longest cable cross the sea in the world. Then visit **Sunset Town**. On the pearl island of Phu Quoc, in the romantic atmosphere of the Mediterranean town and the immense sea, Kiss Bridge appears as a spectacular symbol of love, intimacy and harmony. This unique bridge takes inspiration from the endless love, the sweet kisses, and the love story of Nguu Lang and Chuc Nu in Vietnamese fairy tales. Transfer back to hotel and overnight in Phu Quoc.

Day 3: Vin Wonder & Safari (B/L/D)



After breakfast, transfer to visit **Phu Quoc Safari**, Vietnam's largest wildlife conservation park, one of the most Safari in Southeast Asia, the park has the area of 500 hectares and is home to around 150 species of rare wild animals (about 3,000 units for all of those species), some of which are white lion, black-and-white ruffed lemur, Bengal tiger, Arabian oryx, and white tiger. More than that, this is also where the largest number of endangered species, like rhinoceros, flamingos, and giraffe are being preserved.

In the afternoon, enjoy **VinWonder** – Vietnam's biggest theme park, the multi-experience playground suitable for all ages, which means you will have plenty of time to indulge yourself in all of the incredible shows and attractions: Fantasy World; Adventure world; Ocean World; Show Once.... In the evening, return to hotel and overnight.

Day 4: Phu Quoc – Flight to Da Nang – ½ City Tour (B/L/D)



Morning, ahead airport for your flight to Da Nang (airfare is not included). Reach Da Nang, transfer to hotel (check in time at 2:00pm onwards). Start the tour by visiting **Marble Mountains** - a cluster of five marble and limestone hills located in Ngũ Hành Sơn District, south of Da Nang city in Vietnam. The mountain is dotted with hundreds of caves, shrines, statues, and pagodas. As you make your way up the first set of steps to the first landing, you'll soon come to the first small Buddhist temple. Every sight and stop along the trail up the mountain is unique and well-worth a visit. As you climb higher up the steep and sometimes slippery marble steps, occasionally the thick jungle surrounding the path will clear, giving an unparalleled view of the breathtaking My Khe nearby. If you are feeling really adventurous, head to the highest point on the mountain for an incredible view of the sea and surrounding landscape. Continue to cross **Dragon Bridge**, the icon bridge of Da Nang city, you can walk along the bridge for a while. The next place is **Linh Ung Son Tra Pagoda**, the largest pagoda in Da Nang City in both term of scale (about 20ha) and artistic architecture. The pagoda is situated on Monkey mountain in the Son Tra Peninsula. It is built with the harmonious combination of the modernity and the tradition of Vietnamese pagoda's architecture. **Linh Ung Pagoda** now is one of appealing tourist attractions of the beautiful coastal city. This is also the harmony between the sea and the mountain in a quiet space, along with the murmur of the sea; simultaneously, the pagoda is also the special place linking Heaven and Earth. The last place is visiting **local market**, free for shopping around about half an hour before going back to hotel.

Day 5: Da Nang – Coconut Jungle – Hoi An Ancient Town & Lantern Boat Ride – Da Nang (B/L/D)



Afternoon, take a tour to Cam Thanh Coconut Village & Hoi An Ancient Town

First destination is **Cam Thanh Coconut Village**, which is located just about 5km from the southeast of the Hoi An old town and easy to approach by car, is a must-visit brimming with the lush charm of coconut groves and a diverse range of flora & fauna. From tranquil boat rides along the river to exploring traditional crafts, you can enjoy the pristine nature with fish swimming beneath the coconut groves and storks nesting above, stroll along the paths to fully embrace the fresh atmosphere, learn about the daily life of Vietnamese fisherman. Then, move forward to **Hoi An ancient town**, also known as **Faifo**, an important international trading port in Vietnam in the 16th century. Nowadays, it is one of the most famous and a must-visit destination on the tourist map of the world. This destination is also a rare place where you can find a **unique blend of Vietnamese, Chinese, and Japanese architectures**... Exploring Hoi An on foot is one of the best ways to absorb the beauty of this city. While walking around Hoi An, exploring the small yet beautiful town, which tourists (even frequent visitors) find to be a place of quiet and peace. The most remarkable views are from the ancient houses, reminding visitors of a long gone past and providing a momentary glimpse of a more subdued and simple time. Visit to **Hoi An Market** many of the town's renowned **Ancient Houses** which boast a remarkable architectural style, **Assembly Halls** of Chinese influence, **Art Craft Manufacturing** and of course the must-see **Japanese Covered Bridge**. These spots are considered as typical architecture styles in Hoi An and reflect clearly the cross culture among **France, Japan, China and Vietnam**. Passing over hundreds of years and withstanding the severity of the weather, Hoi An still exists and keeps the ancient and quiet beauty... Free for shopping till going back to your hotel. Overnight in Da Nang

Day 6: Da Nang – Full Day Ba Na Hills – Golden Bridge – Da Nang (B/L/D)



Morning, transfer to **Ba Na Hills**. Arrive at the Cable car station at the foot of Ba Na Mountain. Enjoy **the first leg Cable car**, which achieves two Guinness World Records in 2009, longest non-stop cable car (5,042m) and highest non-stop cable car (1,292m). Sitting in the cabin, in mid-air, looking upon the endless tree line of the forests, bring you with

spectacular views of the lush jungle and fairly waterfalls along the way. First, step on **Golden Bridge** which stands 1,400m above sea level in the Ba Na hills, extends over the treetops from the edge of a leafy cliff face offering tourists uninterrupted views of the majestic landscape beneath. The Golden Bridge is the latest tourist attraction in Da Nang and has attracted hordes of guests since it opened. Visit remains of **French Villas** and **Ling Ung Pagoda** with 27m high Buddha status. We then leave for the second cable car station to visit the top of mountain and see the remain of old villas. Conquer **the Peak of Chua Mountain** at the height of 1,487m. View the whole Da Nang city under the cluster of white clouds. Leave Peak of Chua Mountain, visit the **trail of Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley**, and ruined **Opera House**. Enjoy **105 free games** in **Fantasy Park**, which is the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with a series of interesting games such as 4D – 5D film, skiver, the death race, dinosaur park... Play with wild monkeys and take photos, freely then we return to Cable car station at foot of Ba Na Mountain. Back to the hotel & overnight in Da Nang

Day 7: Da Nang – Flight to Hanoi – ½ City Tour & Cyclo (B/L/D)



Today take a flight to Hanoi. We pick you up from the airport and transfer to Hanoi downtown, check in hotel (check in time 2pm). Afterwards, we start **half day Hanoi city tour**. Hanoi, the vibrant capital of Vietnam, offers a captivating blend of ancient temples, bustling markets, and rich history amidst its charming French colonial architecture... Start the tour by visiting **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum** with **Ba Dinh square (outside)**, where you can also see **Vietnam Parliament House** and **President Palace**. Next place is one of the most beautiful Pagoda of Hanoi named **Tran Quoc pagoda** on an island of Hanoi West Lake, regarded as the most ancient pagoda in Hanoi with its history line dating back to more than 1,500 years: A cultural relic - A religious institute - A historical witness. Stopover to visit **Hoan Kiem Lake** where is central point of Hanoi city, then take a cyclo around

Hanoi Old Quarter with small streets & old houses, feel friendly people with typical Vietnamese smiles offer you the true feeling of this capital city... Return to your hotel & Overnight

Day 8: Hanoi – Ha Long Bay with Overnight on Cruise (B/L/D)



Today we leave Hanoi to Halong bay, "**Dragon Descending to the Sea**". Halong Bay is one of the most beautiful and impressive sights in Vietnam. Ha long Bay has twice been recognized by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Area for its exceptional scenic beauty and one of the world's greatest natural wonders. Upon arrival, we will embark to **an overnight Cruise**. Check in your beautiful room with Ocean view from your bed. Enjoy Lunch at cruise's luxury restaurant while the cruise goes around limestone islands, floating villages and beaches on Ha Long bay... Stop for swimming if weather permitted. Have dinner on board. Overnight on board.
